My artwork expresses digital culture and communication, climate change and technological development and redundancy. In 2021 I received an MA in Fine Art with distinction from Central Saint Martins where I was awarded the South Square Trust Bursary, and later the 2022 Clifford Chance UAL Award for Sculpture. I am a 2023 Gilbert Bayes Award winner with the Royal Society of Sculptors and am also a society member.
