Profile

Louise Ward Morris is an award-winning sculptor specialising in New Media. She uses discarded technology like mobile phones, computers and TVs as materials to reveal the environmental and social consequences of technology's lifecycle. Her artwork addresses digital culture and communication, climate change, technological development and obsolescence from an LGBTQ+, feminist perspective, focusing on issues like e-waste.

She was awarded the 2023 Royal Society of Sculptors' Gilbert Bayes Award for exceptional emerging sculptors and the 2022 Clifford Chance UAL Award for Sculpture. In 2021, Louise received an MA in Fine Art with distinction from Central Saint Martins supported by the South Square Trust Bursary. Upon graduation, she was shortlisted for the 2021 Global Design Graduate Award and exhibited at the Saatchi Gallery's 2021 London Grads Now. Her work is in the UAL Collection and is funded by organisations like the Arts Council.
